## HAPPY COTTON BOOK 8 SEASONAL BUNTING



SEASONAL BUNTING
Crochet colourful bunting for high days and holidays. Stitch a harvest festival, go a little batty at Halloween and deck the halls for Christmas.

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SIRDAR HAPPY


HOWTO BASIC STITCHES MAGIC RING


Repeat the previous step to get two loops on the crochet hook. Take the yarn and pass it through both loops


Repeat until you have the number if stitches needed

Insert the crochet hook through he first stitch and make a slip stitch to close the ring

## CHAIN STITCH

With the sliding knot on your crochet hook, cast on the yarn by passing it through the loop.


## SLIP STITCH

Insert the crochet hook into the stitch, hook the yarn and take it through the two loops.


## DOUBLE CROCHET

Insert the crochet hook through the stitch, hook the yarn and pull it through the loop; there will be 2 loops on the hook. Hook the yarn again and take it through both loops.


## TREBLE CROCHET

Hook the yarn before inserting the crochet hook into the stitch and take it through the loop. Hook the yarn again and take it through the first two loops. Hook the yarn once more and pull it through the two remaining loops.



## HALF TREBLE CROCHET

Hook the yarn before inserting the hook from front to back in the centre of the third chain. Hook the yarn and draw through 3 loops on hook. To repeat hook the yarn, insert hook in the centre of next chain, hook the yarn, draw yarn through stitch, hook the yarn draw yarn through 3 loops on hook.

## 

TO INCREASE
Increasing is achieved by working two or more stitches in the pattern where there would normally be one stitch worked.


## TO DECREASE

Insert the hook into thee next stitch, wind the yarn round the hook and draw a loop through. Repeat this action into the following stitch (three loops now on the hook). Wind the yarn round the hook and draw it through all three loops.

## METHOD - BAT

HEAD (make 2 PIECES)
Make in Colour A.
Rnd I: Start 6dc in a magic ring. (6 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st. ( 12 sts )
Rnd 3: *Idc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(18 sts)
Rnd 4: *2dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. ( 24 sts )
Rnd 5: *3dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (30 sts)
Rnd 6: (2dc into next st) 5 times, 5dc, (2dc into next st) 5 times, 15 dc . ( 40 sts )
Rnd 7: 25dc, I htr, Itr, (Itr, Idtr, Ich, I dtr, Itr) all into next st, sl st into next st, 5dc (Itr, Idtr, Ich, Idtr, Itr) all into next st, I htr, sl st into next st, Ihtr, sl st to close.
Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

## LEFTWING

Make 2 in Colour B.
Make IIch.

Row I: Itr into 3rd ch from hook, 2tr into next ch, ( I tr, I dtr, I ch, I dtr, I tr) all into next ch, Idc, Itr, (2tr, Ihtr) into next ch, Idc into each of last 3ch.
Row 2: Working along the other side of the chain sts, 8dc, sl st to close.

## RIGHTWING

Make 2 in Colour B
Make 10ch.
Row I: Idc into 2nd ch from hook, Idc into each of next 8ch. (9 sts)
Row 2: Work along the other side of ch as follows:- 3dc, ( I htr, 2tr) into next ch, Itr, Idc, (Itr, Idtr, Ich, Idtr, Itr) in next st, 2tr.
Fasten off.

## METHOD - GHOST

HEAD (make 3 pieces)
Make 2 in Colour C
Rnd I: Start 6dc in a magic ring. (6 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st. ( 12 sts )
Rnd 3: *Idc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (18 sts)
Rnd 4: *2dc, 2 dc into next st* repeat around. (24 sts)
Rnd 5: *3dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (30 sts)
Rnd 6: *4dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (36 sts)
Rnd 7: *5dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (42 sts)
Row 8: I3dc, sl st, Ich, turn.

Row 9: 13dc Ich, turn.
Row 10: 13dc, 2ch, turn
Row II: miss I st, 3tr into next st, miss next st, 2dc, tr4 into next st, miss next 2 sts, $1 d c$, miss next st, tr3 into next st, miss next st, Idc. Fasten off.

## I-CORD

Using colour D, make an i-cord approximately 100 cm in length as follows:-
Make 3ch
Insert hook into 2nd ch from hook.
Yarn over and pull through (2 loops on hook). With both loops on the hook, insert hook into last ch, yarn over and pull through (3 loops on hook).

* Take hook out of last two loops and hold
them so they don't unravel (I loop on hook). Yarn over and pull through loop on hook (I loop on hook).
Release the 2nd stitch and insert hook, yarn over and pull through (2 loops on hook) Release the 3rd st, insert hook, yarn over and pull through (3 loops on hook).*
Repeat from * to * to create a cord that rolls in on itself, creating a small tube.
If you need to stop you can put the 3 sts on a safety pin so they don't unravel.
To fasten off pull yarn through all 3 loops on hook and weave in end.


## TO COMPLETE

Pin out the bat heads, wings and ghosts, cover with damp cloths and leave until dry.

Sew wings to either side of bat heads.
Insert safety eyes (or these can be glued on if desired so that they don't show on the reverse)
Smudge a very small circle of blusher
underneath the eyes of the ghosts and bats (optional).
Sew bats and ghosts to the i-cord (refer to photograph for position).

STRIPED BUNTING (make 3 pieces)
Row I: (Colour A), 4ch, work Itr into 4th ch from hook, turn. (2 sts)
Row 2: (Colour B) 3ch (3ch counts as I st), Itr into base of 3ch sp, 2tr into next st, turn. (4 sts)
ball
ball Row 3: (Colour A) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each of next 2tr, 2tr into last st, turn. (6 sts).
Row 4: (Colour B) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each of next 4tr, 2 tr into last st, turn. (8 sts)
Row 5: (Colour A) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each of next 6tr, 2 tr into last st, turn. ( 10 sts )
Row 6: (Colour B) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each of next 8tr, 2 tr into last st, turn ( 12 sts )
Row 7: (Colour A) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each of next IOtr, 2tr into last st, turn.
(14 sts)
Row 8: (Colour B) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each tr to last st, 2tr into last st, turn. (16 sts)
Row 9: (Colour A) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each tr to last st, 2 tr into last st, turn. (18 sts)
Rows IO tol3: As Row 8 and 9 rep twice. (26 sts).

## POPCORN BUNTING

The colour combinations for this bunting are: Colour I = Colour C, Colour 2 = Colour D (make I piece)
Colour I = Colour E, Colour 2 = Colour F (make I piece)
Colour I = Colour D, Colour 2 = Colour E (make I piece)

Row I: (Colour I) 4ch, work Itr into 4th ch from hook, turn. (2 sts)
Row 2: 3ch (3ch counts as I st), I tr into base of 3 ch sp , 2 tr into next st, turn. ( 4 sts )
Row 3: 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each of next $2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ into last st, turn. (6 sts) Row 4: (Colour 2) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into next tr, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 2 sts, 2 tr into last st, turn. (8 sts).
Row 5: (Colour I) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each of next 6 sts, 2 tr into last st, turn. (10 sts)
Row 6: (Colour 2) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into next st, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 4 sts, I pc into next st, Itr into next st,

2 tr into last st, turn. (12 sts).
Row 7: (Colour I) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp , Itr into each of next 10 sts, 2 tr into last st, turn. (14 sts)
Row 8: (Colour 2) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into next st, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 3 sts, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 4 st, Ipc into next st, Itr into next st, 2tr into last st, turn. (16 sts).
Row 9: (Colour I) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each tr to last st, 2tr into last st, turn. (18 sts)
Row 10: (Colour 2) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp , Itr into next st, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 3 sts, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 4 sts, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 3 sts, Ipc into next st, Itr into next st, 2tr into last st, turn. (20 sts). Row II: (Colour I) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, I tr into each tr to last $s t, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ into last st, turn. (22 sts).
Row I2: (Colour 2) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into next st, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 3 sts, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 4 sts, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 3 sts, Ipc into next st, Itr into each of next 3 sts, Ipc into next st, Itr into next st, 2 tr into last st, turn. ( 24 sts ).
Row 13: (Colour I) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each tr to last st, 2 tr into last st, turn. (26 sts).

TWO-TONE BUNTING
The colour combinations for this bunting are: Colour I = Colour D, Colour 2 = Colour C (make I piece)
Colour I = Colour E, Colour 2 = Colour D (make I piece)
Colour I = Colour D, Colour 2 = Colour F (make I piece)

Row I: (Colour I) 4ch,Work Itr into 4th ch from hook, turn. (2 sts)
Row 2: 3ch (3ch counts as I st), Itr into base of 3 ch sp , 2 tr into next st, turn. ( 4 sts )
Row 3: 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each of next 2 tr , 2 tr into last st, turn. ( 6 sts ). Row 4: 3ch, Itr into base of 3 ch sp , Itr into each of next $4 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ into last st, turn. (8 sts) Row 5: 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each of next $6 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ into last st, turn. ( 10 sts ) Row 6: 3ch, Itr into base of 3 ch sp , Itr into each of next $8 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ into last st, turn. ( 12 sts ) Row 7: (Colour 2) 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each of next $10 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ into last st, turn. (14 sts)
Row 8: 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, Itr into each tr to last st, 2tr into last st, turn. (16 sts) Row 9 to 13: As Row 8. Rep 5 times. ( 26 sts).

## TO COMPLETE

Once all nine pieces have been made up, alternating the colours as you desire, join them with Colour A as follows:- make 20ch,* work 26 dc along the top edge of each bunting piece,
makel0 ch to separate the pieces*, rep from * to * until all pieces have been joined together ending with another 20ch.
 within the texture try working them as invisible decreases - pick up front loops of two stitches, yarn over and pull I loop through, yarn over and pull through both loops on hook

Rnd I: Start 5 dc into a magic ring. (5 sts)
Rnd 2: Idc into each st around. (5 sts)
Rnd 3: 2dc into each st around. (10 sts)
Rnd 4-5: Idc into each st around.
Rnd 6: *Idc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(15 sts)
Rnd 7 -8: Idc into each st around. (15 sts) Fasten off.

CAP (MAKE 3 PIECES)
Make in Colour B.
Rnd I: Start 6dc into a magic ring. (6 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around. ( 12 sts )
Rnd 3: *Idc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(18 sts)
Rnd 4-5: Idc into each st around. (18 sts)
Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

TO COMPLETE
To assemble, stuff the body and sew the cap on top.
To make the stalk, make a French knot in
Colour B on the top of the cap.

## METHOD - MUSHROOMS

BODY (make 3 PIECES)
Make 2 in Colour D and I in Colour A.
Rnd I: Start 6dc into a magic ring. (6 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around. (12 sts)
Rnd 3 - 10 : Idc into each st around. ( 12 sts)
Rnd II: 2dc into each st around. (24 sts)
Fasten off.
CAP (MAKE 3 PIECES)
Make 2 in Colour $C$ and $I$ in Colour B.
Rnd I: Start 5dc into a magic ring. (5 sts)
Rnd 2: Idc into each st around. (5 sts)
Rnd 3: 2dc into each st around. (10 sts)
Rnd 4: Idc into each st around. ( 10 sts)
Rnd 5: *Idc, 2dc into next dc* repeat around.
(15 sts)
Rnd 6: Idc into each st around.
Rnd 7: *2dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(20 sts)
Rnd 8: Idc into each st around. (20 sts)
Rnd 9: *3dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. ( 25 sts )
Rnd IO: Idc into each st around. (25 sts)
Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

## TO COMPLETE

To assemble, stuff the body and cap and sew the pieces together.

## METHOD - LARGE LEAVES

Make 3 leaves - I in Colour A, I in Colour B and I in Colour C .
Rnd I: Start 3ch, I Itr into a magic ring, sl st to top of 3 ch . ( 12 sts )
Rnd 2: 3ch, Itr into base of 3ch sp, 2tr into each of next II sts, sl st to top of 3 ch . ( 24 sts ) Rnd 3: Ich, miss next st, 5tr into next st, * miss next st, Idc, miss next st, 5 tr,* rep from * to* 3 times more, miss next st, Idc, sl st into each of next 2 sts, 5 ch, work Idc into 2 nd ch from hook, Idc into each of next 3ch, sl st into lst ch.
Rnd 4: Idc into first of 5 tr, I Ihtr into next st, ( $2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{ch}$, sl st in second tr just made, Itr ) all in the next st, Ihtr, Idc, sl st into dc, *Idc, Ihtr, (2tr, 2ch, sl st in second tr just made, Itr) all in the next st, Ihtr, Idc, sl st into dc* 4 times, sl st into next st.
Fasten off.

## METHOD - SMALL LEAVES

Make 5 small leaves -2 in Colour A, 1 in Colour B and 2 in Colour C Make 10ch.
Rnd I: Idc into 2nd ch from hook, Idc into each of next 7ch, $2 d c$ into last ch, Idc into each of other side of next 9 ch , sl st, 4ch, sl st into 2 nd ch from hook, sl st into next 2 ch , sl st

## to close

Row 2: Idc into each of next 3 sts, *(I htr, 2tr Ihtr) into next st, Idc into each of next 2 sts* repeat from * to * 4 times more, Idc into next st, sl st.

TO COMPLETE
Thread a needle with a strand of Colour C approximately 130 cm in length. Arranging mushroooms, acorns and leaves as desired, thread them onto the length of yarn as shown in photograph.

Rnd 3: *Idc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(18 sts)
Rnd 4: *2dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(24 sts)
Rnd 5: *3dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (30 sts)
Rnd 6: *4dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(36 sts)
Rnd 7: *5dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(42 sts)
Rnd 8: *6dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (48 sts)
Rnds 9-14: Idc into each st around.
Rnd 15: *6dc, dc2tog* repeat around. (42 sts) Rnd 16: Idc into each st around.
Place eyes between rnds I2-13, separated by 8 sts.
Rnd 17: *5dc, dc2tog* repeat around. (36 sts) Rnd 18: Idc into each dc around.
Add stuffing to the head as you decrease
Rnd 19: *4dc, dc2tog* repeat around. (30 sts) Rnd 20: *3dc, dc2tog* repeat around. (24 sts) Rnd 21 : *2dc, dc2tog* repeat around. (18 sts) Rnd 22: *Idc, dc2tog* repeat around. (12 sts) Rnd 23: dc2tog 6 times. (6 sts)
Finish with a sl st.
Fasten off, pick up all the front loops with a needle and pull tight to close.

## METHOD - FATHER CHRISTMAS

## HEAD

Using Colour D, work as given for Head Pattern.
HAT
Start in Colour B.
Rnd I: Start 3dc into a magic ring. (3 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around. (6 sts)
Rnd 3: 2dc into each st around. ( 12 sts)
Rnd 4-7: Idc into each st around.
Rnd 8: *Idc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.

## (18 sts)

Rnd 9-12: Idc into each st around.

Rnd 13: *2dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (24 sts)
Rnds 14-17: Idc into each st around.
Rnd I8: *3dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (30 sts)
Rnds 19-20: Idc into each st around.
Rnd 2I: *4dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(36 sts)
Rnd 22: Idc into each st around.
Rnd 23: *5dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(42 sts)
Rnd 24: *6dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (48 sts)
Rnd 25: Idc into each st around.
Rnd 26: *7dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (54 sts)
Rnds 27-29: Idc into each st around.
Change to Colour A.
Rnd 30: Idc into each st around.
Rnd 3I: work Itr through front of loop of
each st around, sl st into first tr.
Fasten off.

## MOUSTACHE

Using Colour A, make IOch.
SI st into 2nd ch from hook, * Idc into next ch, Ihtr into next ch, Idc into next ch, sl st into next ch* twice, Ich, turn the work and continue along the other side of the chain, sl st, repeat from * to * twice, sl st to end ch. Fasten off.

## BEARD

Using Colour A, make 26ch
Row I: work Idc into 2 nd ch from hook, Idc into each of next 24 ch , turn. ( 25 sts )
Row 2: Ich (Ich does not count as a st), 4dc,
17tr, 4dc, turn. (25 sts)
Row 3: Ich, 6dc, 4tr, 5dtr, 4tr, 6dc, turn. (25
sts)
Row 4: Ich, 7dc, 4tr, 3dtr, 4tr, 7dc. (25 sts) Fasten off.

TO FINISH FATHER CHRISTMAS
Fold up the last round of the hat. Make a small pompom in Colour A to sew on top of hat.
Using sewing thread sew hat and beard onto head making sure that there is no gap between the ends of the beard and the hat. Sew on moustache. Embroider eyebrows in Colour A and nose in Colour B (refer to photograph).

## HEAD

Using Colour D, work as given for Head Pattern.
HAT
Start in Colour C
Rnd I: Start 6 dc into a magic ring. (6 sts)
Rnd 2: Idc into each st around. (6 sts)
Change to Colour A.
Rnd 3: Idc into each st around
Rnd 4: 2dc into each st around. (12 sts)
Change to Colour C.
Rnd 5-6: Idc into each st around.

Change to Colour A.
Rnd 7: *Idc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(18 sts)
Rnd 8: Idc into each st around.
Change to Colour C .
Rnd 9: *2dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(24 sts)
Rnd IO: Idc into each st around.
Change to Colour A.
Rnd II: *3dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (30 sts)
Rnd I2: Idc into each st around.
Change to Colour C.
Rnd 13: *4dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (36 sts)
Rnd I4: Idc into each st around.
Change to Colour A.
Rnd I5: *5dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(42 sts)
Rnd I6: Idc into each dc to end of rnd.
Change to Colour C.
Rnd I7: *6dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (48 sts)
Rnd I8: Idc into each st around.
Change to Colour A.
Rnd 19: *7dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (54 sts)
Rnd 20: Idc into each st around.
Change to Colour C.
Rnd 21: Idc into each st around.
Rnd 22: Ihtr into each st around, sl st to Ist htr.
Fasten off

EARS
Make 2, start in Colour D.
Rnd I:Work 3dc into a magic ring. (3 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around. (6 sts)
Rnd 3: Idc into each st around, sl st into Ist dc.

Fasten off.
TO FINISH ELF
Make a small pompom in Colour A to decorate the hat.
Embroider the nose with 2 straight sts in Colour D, lopsided mouth with I straight st in Colour B and hair with a few straight sts to indicate a fringe in Colour E (refer to photograph).
Sew hat onto head using sewing thread.

## METHOD - REINDEER

## HEAD

Using Colour F, work as given for Head Pattern

## BIG ANTLERS

Make 2 in Colour E
Rnd I: Start 3 dc into a magic ring. (3 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around. (6 sts) Rnds 3-5: Idc into each st around,
Sl st into Ist dc of last rnd, fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

SMALL ANTLERS
Make 2 in Colour E.
Rnd I: Start 5 dc into a magic ring. (5 sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around. (10 sts)
Rnd 3: *Idc into st, 2dc into next st* repeat around, sl st into lst dc. (15 sts)
SI st into Ist st of last rnd, fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

## SNOUT

Make 2 in Colour D.
Rnd I:Work 5dc into the magic ring. (5 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around. ( 10 sts )
Rnd 3: *Idc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(15 sts)
SI st into Ist st of last rnd, fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

## NOSE

Make in Colour B.
Rnd I:Work 4dc into a magic ring. (4 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around. (8 sts)
SI st into Ist st, fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

## EARS

Make 2 in Colour $F$
Rnd I:Start 4dc into a magic ring. (4 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around. (8 sts)
Rnd 3: *Idc into st, 2dc into next st* repeat around. ( 12 sts )
Rnd 4: Idc into each st around
Rnd 5: dc2tog 6 times. (6 sts)
Rnd 6: Idc into each st around. (6 sts)
SI st into Ist dc of last rnd, fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

BOW
Using Colour C, make 25ch
Work Idc into 2nd ch from hook, Idc into each ch to end.
Sl st into the other side of each ch back along to the Ist ch.
Join ends together making a circle and join in the middle to form bow shape.

## TO FINISH REINDEER

Sew I small antler piece to side of I large antler piece and repeat with the other 2 antle pieces. Sew antlers onto head. Sew the ears either side of the antlers.
Sew snout, nose and bow onto front of head refer to photograph for positioning. Embroider a mouth below the nose with I straight st of Colour B.

## METHOD - SNOWMAN

## HEAD

Using Colour A work as given for Head Pattern.
HAT
Make I in Colour E.
Rnd I: Start 6dc into a magic ring. (6 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around (12 sts)
Rnd 3: *Idc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (18 sts)
Rnd 4: *2dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(24 sts)
Rnd 5: *3dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(30 sts)
Rnd 6: *4dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(36 sts)
Rnd 7: Idc into front loop only of each st around. (36 sts)
Rnd 8-13: Idc into each st around, sl st into Ist dc. (36 sts)
Rnd 14: 2ch, 2tr into each st around, sl st into top of Ist ch. (72 sts)
Fasten off.

## BOW TIE

Using Colour C make 4ch
2dtr into 4th ch from hook, 3ch, sl st in same ch, 3ch, work 2 dtr into same ch, 3ch, sl st in same ch. Fasten off.

## TO FINISH SNOWMAN

Sew hat onto head using sewing thread.
Embroider the mouth and cheeks - 2 straight sts in Colour B for the cheeks and a curved line for the mouth (refer to photograph for positioning of features)
Sew bow-tie below mouth.

## METHOD - GINGERBREAD

HEAD
Using Colour F, work as given for Head Pattern.

## CREAM FROSTING

Make I in Colour A
Rnd I: Start 7dc into a magic ring. (7 sts)
Rnd 2: 2dc into each st around. (14 sts)
Rnd 3: *Idc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (2l sts)
Rnd 4: *2dc, 2 dc into next st* repeat around.
(28 sts)
Rnd 5: *3dc, 2 dc into next st* repeat around.
(35 sts)
Rnd 6: *4dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around.
(42 sts)
Rnd 7: *5dc, 2dc into next st* repeat around. (49 sts)

Rnd 8: Ich, * Idc, 2htr, 3tr, 3dtr, 3tr, $2 \mathrm{htr}, \mid \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{sl}$ st *, repeat from * to * 2 times more.
Fasten off.
CHEEKS
Make 2 in Colour B.
Rnd I: Work 6 dc into a magic ring, sl st to
Ist dc.
Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing

TO FINISH GINGERBREAD
Sew the cream frosting on top of the head with sewing thread. Sew the cheeks on each side of the front of the head. Embroider the mouth with a curved line in Colour B. Embroider different colour sprinkles in Colours B, C and E on top of the cream frosting.

## TO COMPLETE GARLAND

Using 4 strands of each of Colours A, B and C make a twisted cord approximately 70 cm in length.
Thread short lengths of ribbon through the tops of the various heads and tie ribbons into loops to thread onto twisted cord.
