## BACK

Using 4 mm needles and thumb method cast on 97 [107:117:127:135:145] sts.
1st Row. * K1, p1, rep from * to last st, k1.
2nd Row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.
1 st and 2 nd rows set $\mathbf{1 x} \mathbf{1}$ rib.
Work in $1 \times 1$ rib for $8 \mathrm{~cm},(3 \mathrm{in})$, ending with a ws row.
Proceed as follows:-
1st Row. Knit.
2nd Row. * P1, k1B, rep from *
to last st, p1.
1st and 2 nd rows set half fishermans rib.
Working in half fishermans rib as set
(throughout) cont until back measures 27 [27:27:28:29:30]cm, (103/4 [103/4:103/4: 11:111/2:113/4]in), ending with a ws row.

## Shape Raglan

Cast off 5 [5:5:6:6:6] sts in patt at beg of next 2 rows. 87 [97:107:115:123:133] sts.
1st Row. K2, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. 85 [95:105:113:121:131] sts.
2nd Row. P3, patt to last 3 sts, p3.

3rd Row. Knit.
4th Row. P3, patt to last 3 sts, p3.
From 1st to 4th row sets raglan shapings.
Work 60 [56:52:44:36:20] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in next and every foll 4th row.
55 [67:79:91:103:121] sts.
1st Row. K2, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. 53 [65:77:89:101:119] sts.
2nd Row. P3, patt to last 3 sts, p3.
1st and 2 nd rows set raglan shapings.
Work 8 [18:30:40:52:70] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in next and every foll alt row.
45 [47:47:49:49:49] sts.
Leave rem 45 [47:47:49:49:49] sts on a stitch holder.

## LEFT FRONT

Using 4 mm needles and thumb method cast on 46 [50:56:60:64:70] sts.
1st Row. * K1, p1, rep from * to end.
1st row sets rib.
Work in rib for 8 cm , (3in), ending
with a ws row.
1st Row. Knit.
2nd Row. K1, * p1, k1B, rep from *
to last st, p1.
1st and 2nd rows set half fishermans rib.
Working in half fishermans rib as set
(throughout) cont until left front measures 27 [27:27:28:29:30]cm, (103/4 [103/4:103/4:11:111/2:113/4]in), ending with a ws row.

## Shape Raglan

Cast off 5 [5:5:6:6:6] sts, knit to end. 41 [45:51:54:58:64] sts.
Next Row. Patt.
1st Row. K2, s1, k1, psso, knit to end.
40 [44:50:53:57:63] sts.
2nd Row. Patt to last 3 sts, p3.
3rd Row. Knit.
4th Row. Patt to last 3 sts, p3.
From 1st to 4th row sets raglan shaping.
Work 60 [56:52:44:36:20] rows dec 1 st
at raglan edge as before in next and every foll 4th row.
25 [30:37:42:48:58] sts.
1st Row. K2, s1, k1, psso, knit to end. 24 [29:36:41:47:57] sts.
2nd Row. Patt to last 3 sts, p3. 1st and 2 nd rows set raglan shaping.
Work 1 [13:25:37:49:67] rows dec 1 st at
raglan edge as before in next and every foll 0 [2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd] row.
23 [22:23:22:22:23] sts.

## Shape Neck

Next Row. Cast off 14 [15:16:16:
16:17] sts in patt, patt to last 3 sts, p3.
9 [7:7:6:6:6] sts.
Work 4 [2:2:2:2:2] rows dec 1 st at raglan edge as before in next and foll 2nd [0:0: $0: 0: 0$ ] row AT SAME TIME dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll 2nd [0:0:0:0:0] row. 5 [5:5:4:4:4] sts.

## For 1st, 2nd and 3rd sizes only

Work 2 rows dec 1 st at raglan edge only as before in next row. 4 sts.

## For all 6 sizes

Leave rem 4 sts on a stitch holder.

## RIGHT FRONT

Using 4 mm needles and thumb method cast on 46 [50:56:60:64:70] sts.
1st Row. *P1, k1, rep from * to end.
1st row sets rib.
Work in rib for 8 cm , (3in), ending
with a ws row.
1st Row. Knit.
2nd Row. P1, * k1B, p1, rep from *
to last st, k 1 .
1st and 2nd rows set half fishermans rib.
Working in half fishermans rib as set
(throughout) cont until right front
measures 27 [27:27:28:29:30]cm,
(103/4 [103/4:103/4:11:111/2:113/4]in), ending with a rs row.

## Shape Raglan

Cast off 5 [5:5:6:6:6] sts in patt, patt to end. 41 [45:51:54:58:64] sts.
1st Row. Knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.
40 [44:50:53:57:63] sts.
2nd Row. P3, patt to end.
3rd Row. Knit.
4th Row. P3, patt to end.
From 1st to 4th row sets raglan shaping. Work 60 [56:52:44:36:20] rows dec 1 st at raglan edge as before in next and every foll 4th row.
25 [30:37:42:48:58] sts.
1st Row. Knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. 24 [29:36:41:47:57] sts.
2nd Row. P3, patt to end.

1st and 2 nd rows set raglan shaping. Work 0 [12:24:36:48:66] rows dec 1 st at raglan edge as before in 0 [1st:1st:1st: 1st:1st] and every foll 0 [2nd:2nd:2nd: 2nd:2nd] row. 24 [23:24:23:23:24] sts.

## Shape Neck

Next Row. Cast off 14 [15:16:16: 16:17] sts, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. 9 [7:7:6:6:6] sts.
Next Row. P3, patt to end.
Work 4 [2:2:2:2:2] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll 2nd [0:0:0:0:0] row AT SAME TIME dec 1 st at raglan edge as before in next and foll 2nd [0:0:0:0:0] row. 5 [5:5:4:4:4] sts.

## For 1st, 2nd and 3rd sizes only

Work 2 rows dec 1 st at raglan edge only as before in next row. 4 sts.

## For all 6 sizes

Leave rem 4 sts on a stitch holder.

## SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 4 mm needles and thumb method cast on 49 [53:55:57:59:63] sts.
Work in $1 \times 1$ rib for 12 cm , (43/4in), ending with a rs row.
Next Row. P3 [2:5:2:6:1], inc in next st purlways, (p13 [15:3:3:2:3], inc in next st purlways) 3 [3:11:13:15:15] times, p3 [2:5: 2:7:1]. 53 [57:67:71:75:79] sts.
1st Row. Knit.
2nd Row. Purl.
1st and 2nd rows set st-st (stocking stitch).
Working in st-st (throughout) proceed as follows:-
Next Row. Inc in each of first 2 sts, knit to last 3 sts, inc in each of next 2 sts, k1. 57 [61:71:75:79:83] sts.
Next Row. Purl.
Last 2 rows set sleeve increases.
Inc 2 sts at each end as before in next and every foll alt row to 81 [85:87:87:
91:95] sts.
Inc 2 sts at each end as before in every foll

4th row to 105 [109:119:123:127:131] sts.
Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 48 [48:49:50:50:50]cm, (19 [19:191/4:193/4:193/4:193/4]in), ending with a ws row.

## Shape Raglan

Cast off 5 [5:5:6:6:6] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 95 [99:109:111:115:119] sts.
1st Row. K2, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. 93 [97:107:109:113:117] sts.
2nd Row. P2, p2tog, purl to last 4 sts, p2togtbl, p2. 91 [95:105:107:111:115] sts. 1 st and 2 nd rows set raglan shapings. Work 4 [2:6:4:4:6] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in every row.
83 [91:93:99:103:103] sts.
1st Row. K2, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. 81 [89:91:97:101:101] sts.
2nd Row. Purl.
1st and 2 nd rows set raglan shapings.
Work 50 [56:58:62:66:66] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in next and every foll alt row.
31 [33:33:35:35:35] sts.
Cast off rem 31 [33:33:35:35:35] sts.

## NECKBAND

Join raglan seams. With rs facing, using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles pick up and knit 12 [13: 14:14:14:15] sts evenly from 14 [15:16:16: 16:17] cast off sts at right side of neck, 5 [4:4:3:3:3] sts evenly along right side of neck, knit across 4 sts left on a stitch holder at top of right side of neck, pick up and knit 23 [25:25:27:27:27] sts evenly from 31 [33:33:35:35:35] cast off sts at top of right sleeve, knit across 45 [47: 47:49:49:49] sts left on a stitch holder at back of neck, pick up and knit 23 [25:25: 27:27:27] sts evenly from 31 [33:33:35: 35:35] cast off sts at top of left sleeve, knit across 4 sts left on a stitch holder at top of left side of neck, pick up and knit 5 [4:4:3:3:3] sts evenly along left side of neck and 12 [13:14:14:14:15] sts evenly from 14 [15:16:16:16:17] cast off sts at left side of neck.

133 [139:141:145:145:147] sts.
Starting with 1st row of $1 \times 1$ rib work in rib for 8 cm , (3in), ending with 1st row. Cast off in rib.

## LEFT FRONT BORDER

With rs facing, using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles pick up and knit 20 sts evenly along neckband, 96 [100:104:110:116:120] sts evenly along front edge and 21 sts evenly along rib. 137 [141:145:151:157:161] sts. Starting with 2 nd row of $1 \times 1$ rib work 11 rows.

Cast off in rib.

## RIGHT FRONT BORDER

With rs facing, using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles pick up and knit 21 sts evenly along rib, 96 [100:104:110:116:120] sts evenly along front edge and 20 sts evenly along neckband.

137 [141:145:151:157:161] sts.
Starting with 2 nd row of $1 \times 1$ rib work 4 rows.
Next Row. Rib 4 [4:4:4:3:4], cast off 2 sts, rib 7 [7:7:7:9:7], cast off 2 sts, (rib 26 [27:28:23:24:25], cast off 2 sts) 4 [4:4:5:5:5] times, rib 4.

Next Row. Rib 5, cast on 2 sts, (rib 27 [28:29:24:25:26], cast on 2 sts) 4 [4:4:5:5:5] times, rib 8 [8:8:8:10:8], cast on 2 sts, rib 4 [4:4:4:3:4].
Work 5 rows more in rib.
Cast off in rib.

## TO MAKE UP

Fold neckband in half onto ws and slip stitch loosely in position all around neck edge. Sew edges of neckband and blanket stitch around buttonhole. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
